Decision: Major revisions required

This article covers a very important topic and with some revisions, it can certainly be published. A few things stand out:

a. Please restructure the abstract to reflect 1) purpose, 2) focus, 3) methods, and 4) results of the study in the sequence.

b. There is a lack of the most recent citation from peer-reviewed journals in the paper from (2017 to 2021) in the introduction, Literature Review, and Discussion sections. APA requires the most recent references for academic work. The introduction needs to justify and articulate the focus and questions of this study from the relevant scholarship, policy, and practice perspectives using relevant literature as support.

c. You need to develop research questions at the end of the introduction in alignment with the study focus. Much of the literature review should be revised and incorporated into the introduction section. To enhance the justification and articulation of the focus and questions there as suggested.

d. Also, I believe that more academic literature on this topic should be utilized. You use academic literature throughout, particularly when discussing methods. There are some strong opinions expressed and also parts where there are stats but no citations. Be sure to check citations and include them where necessary. It is obvious that research has been done but I believe this could use a second look.

e. The section, Methodology, needs to be restructured and revised in the

following ways. 1) Explain the participants and contexts of the study in the section, including why they were selected based on the needs of this study. 2) Place the section, Data Collection, after the participant and context section. In the section, you need to explain what data are collected using what instrument, why the data are helpful for the needs of instruction development, how your theoretical framework is used to guide the data collection, and any limitations of this study. For example, how did you recruit the participants, whether they meet the needs of this study, any bias in the participant recruitment, and how well they can represent the intended population of this study. 3) Place the data analysis and instrument development after the data collection. In this section, you need to describe the processes of instrument development, justify each process and articulate it based on the relevant theoretical framework that you developed and research methodology literature.

f. Please develop a discussion section before the conclusion section. In the section, it is necessary to discuss: 1) The significant results of the study, 2) how these results contribute to the current empirical understanding shown in the literature review section as suggested earlier. 3) How the results confirm, extend, and challenge the relevant theoretical conceptions shown in the theoretical framework section as suggested earlier. 4) Propose the relevant future research based on the discussion and relevant limitations of the study.

g. I believe more in-depth information could be gleaned from the findings presented. It is important to make sure that the claims made in the indicative introduction about what the paper will argue are revisited in the summative conclusion (preferably with some brief reference to the main points made in the body of the paper).

h. Revise the rest of paper to ensure this conforms to the standard formatting of Journal of Ethnic and Cultural Studies authors' guideline and – refer to the 7th edition of the APA Publication Manual in this regard. Tables are not formatted in APA style. Needs be formatted in APA 7th version.

k. And look over references to see all in present in the text and vice versa.

l. I am afraid there are some grammatical and English errors in this paper which make it quite hard to read in places and this is sufficient to make it un-publishable in its present form. The article itself is interesting but it is a difficult read given the issues above. I suggest authors always have their work edited by a professional English editor before submissions. Find someone who is a native speaker of English to proofread your paper.

Overall, I feel confident that if you carefully address the reviewers' and our concerns, your manuscript will make a valuable contribution to scholarship and teaching in the field of ethnic and cultural studies.
